




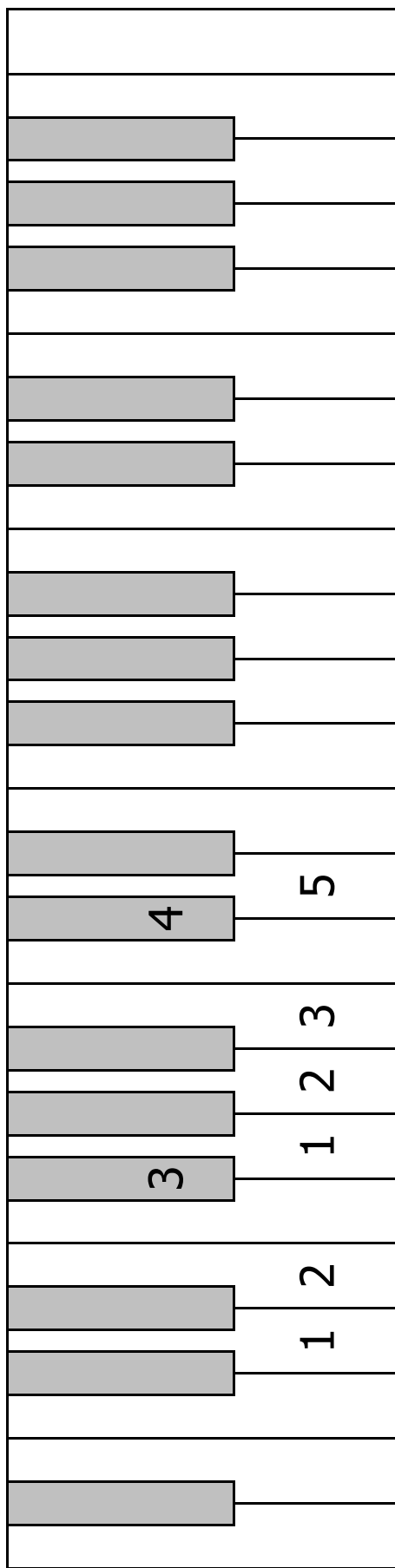

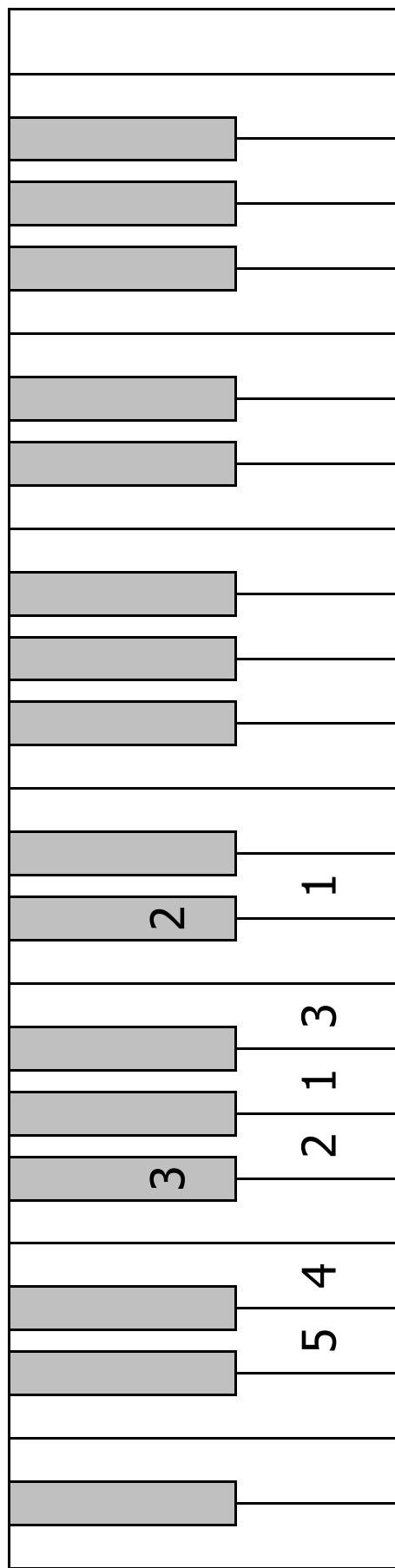

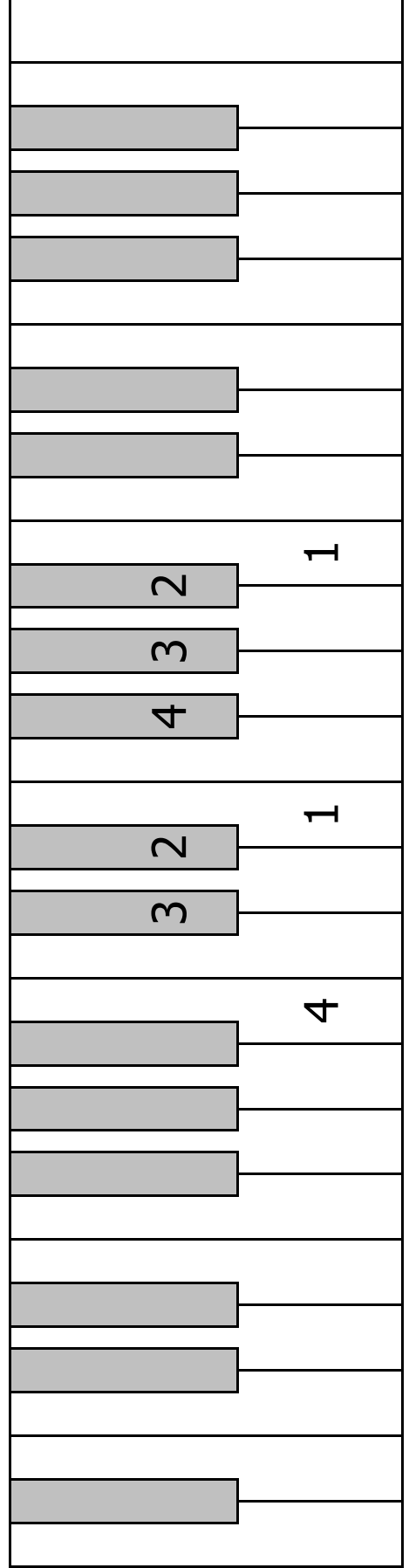
B Major Scale -- One Octave

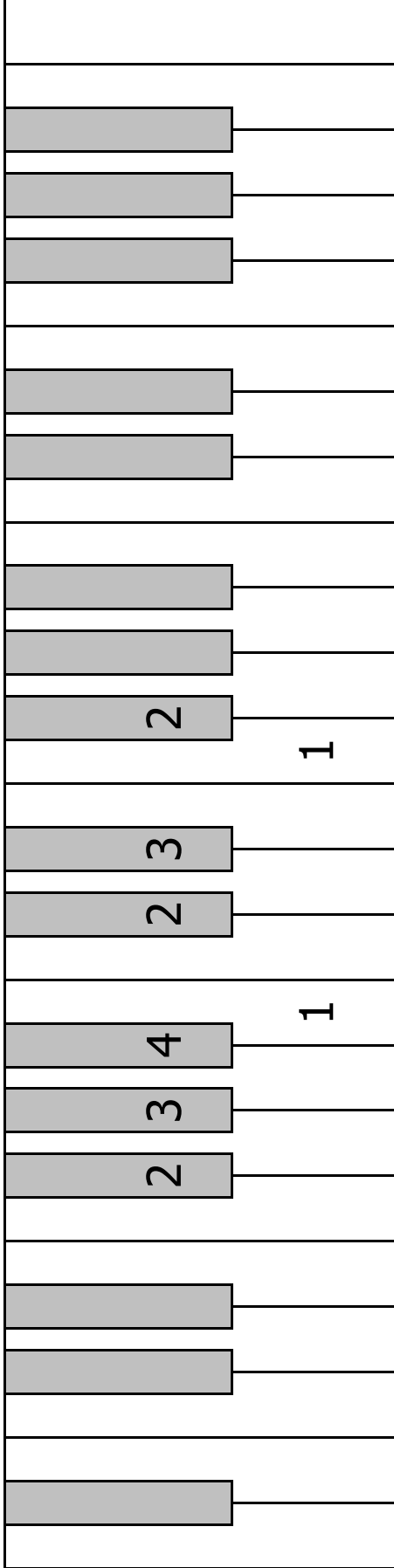

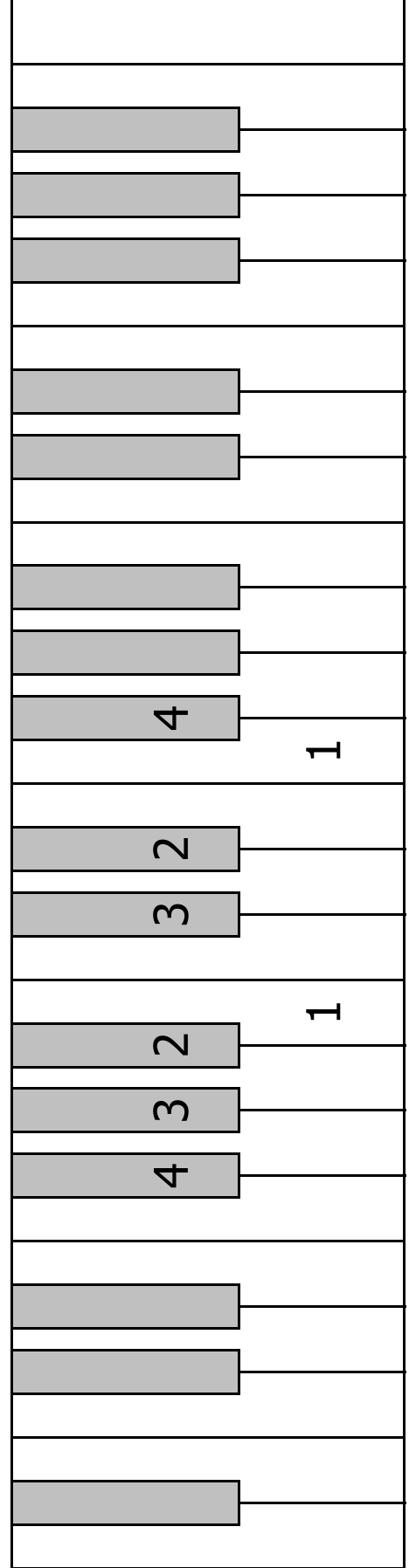
#^b F / G Major Scale -- One Octave

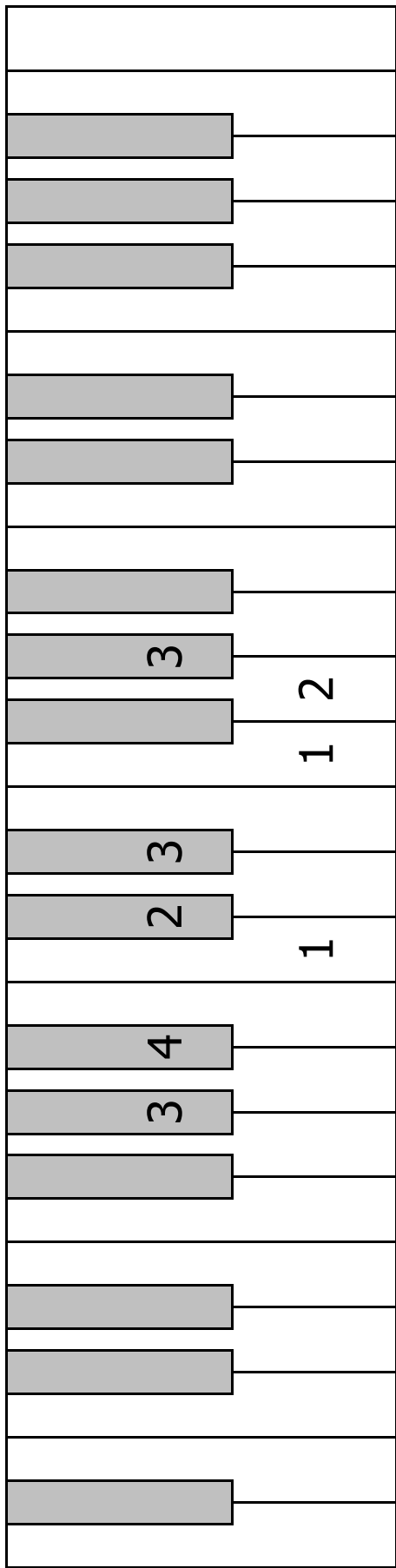

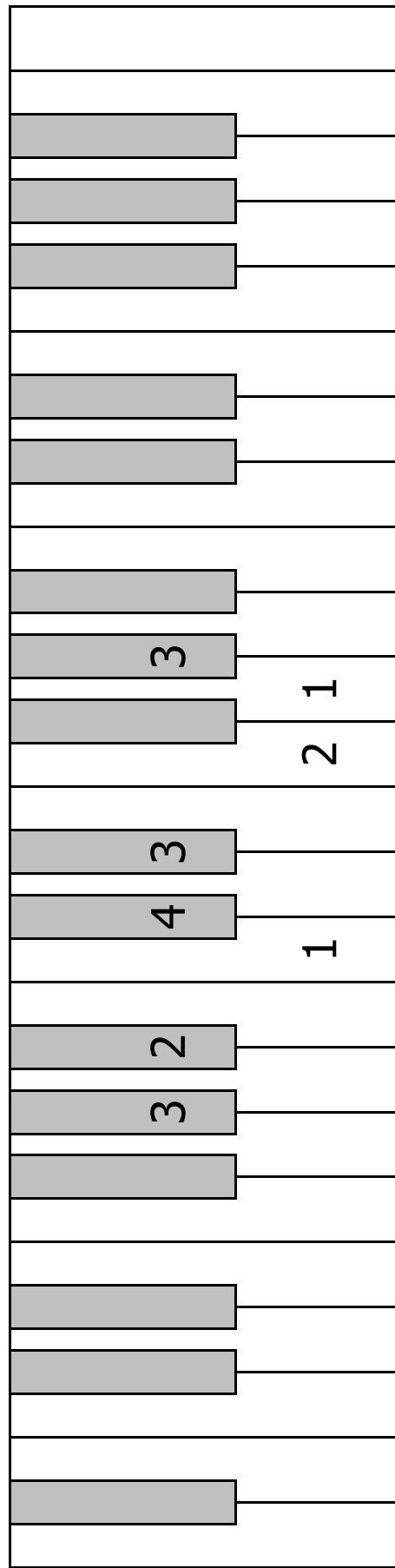

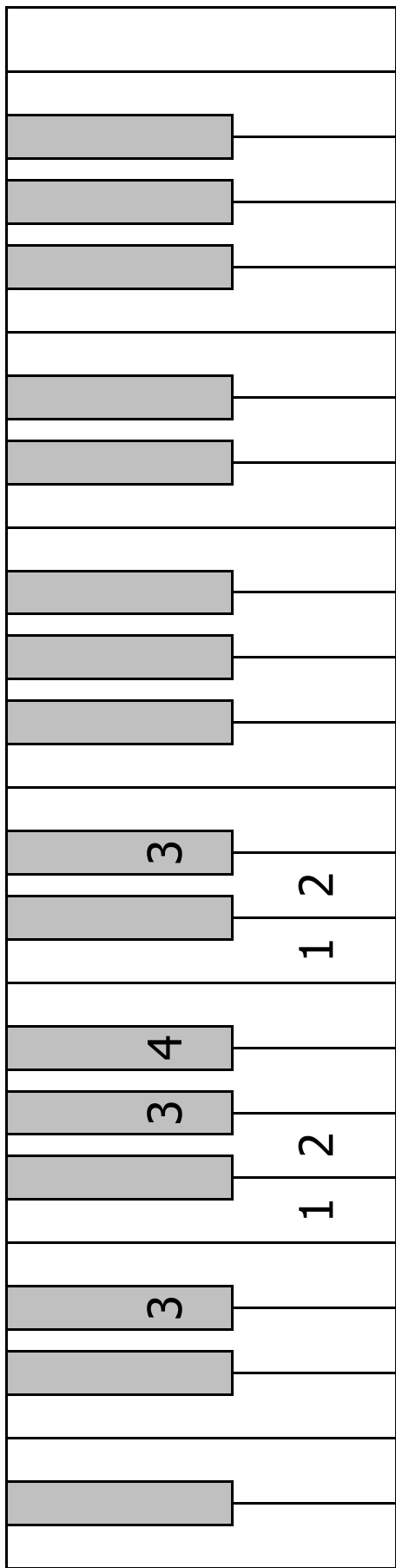

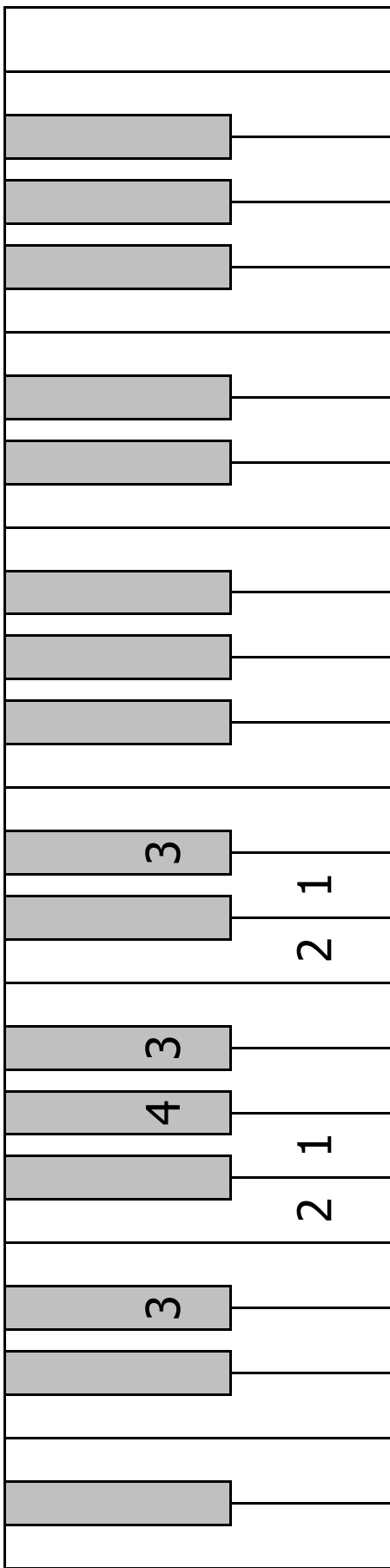
